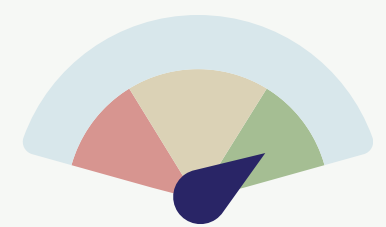

The Allure of Trading Cards

Different collectors are drawn to various aspects of trading card games, such as high-value cards, specific gameplay mechanics, or the appreciation of artwork. Games like Pokémon, Magic: The Gathering, and Yu-Gi-Oh! accommodate these diverse interests, each boasting a loyal fanbase willing to pay a premium for coveted cards, making them appealing for investment or resale.

The Pokémon franchise experienced a notable increase in card values, especially during the pandemic and its 25th anniversary. More time spent at home and increased savings fueled the popularity of Pokémon Trading Cards (TC), driven by nostalgia in the secondary market. Card values are influenced by factors such as condition, edition, language, rarity, and demand, with Charizard, Pikachu, Mewtwo, and first edition Base Set cards being among the most desirable.

The Pikachu Illustrator card is exceptionally rare, awarded to winners of a CoroCoro Comic magazine illustration contest. With only a few in existence, it is extremely valuable. In February 2021, one sold for 350,000 euros, and in February 2022, another set a new record by selling for over 840,000 euros.

Counterfeit card

Because trading cards are so popular, fake games are frequently found on the market. As the category continues to gain popularity, this problem will become even more significant. Therefore, it is crucial to buy only from reputable sellers.

Damaged card

Proper handling and storage of trading cards are essential to preserve their intrinsic value. Nevertheless, in the event of unexpected incidents like human mistakes, fires, or natural disasters, the cards can suffer damage or be completely ruined.

Market conditions

By performing comprehensive due diligence and market analysis, investment-grade assets can be identified. Nonetheless, establishing the correct price for these assets is challenging and involves the risk of overpaying.
