Rating



Return

The **average annual increase** in value of the sought-after Birkin bags since 1985 is at **14.2%**.

According to the 2023 wealth report of Knight Frank, the prices for collectible handbags increased by **74 %** over the last **10 years**.



Stability

The production volume is kept at a low level by Hèrmes. This leads to annual price increases **of 5 up to 10 %** for the primary market of Birkin bags.

The prices on the secondary market follow the increase on the primary market.

The **annual production** of the Birkin bag is around **3,000 pieces**.



Track Record

The idea for the bag came in 1983 when Louis Dumas met the actress, Jane Birkin. When Jane told him about the space problems of handbags, he immediately started to draw trapezoidal bags.

Since **1984** the Birkin bag is the most sought-after handbag. Quality is of utmost importance, and the bags are still handmade from the finest material. The production time is at **48 hours** per bag.

- Investment horizon has been set to 2 to 4 years.
- The investment horizon has been set at short to medium term. It is expected that Hermès will continue to increase prices by 5 to 10% annually and that prices on the secondary market will, therefore, also increase. At the same time, demand in the Chinese market is expected to continue to grow.
- If one of the following two conditions is met, the sale of the asset is considered:
 - End of the defined investment horizon has been reached.
 - Ambitious case already occurs before the end investment horizon.
