Return

According to "The Global Art Market & COVID-19 Report by Citi Private Bank, 2021", **contemporary art turned a profit of 6,7 %, compared to the 5,5 % return of all the other art sectors.**

While the **FTSE 100** Index has decreased by **-12%**, the **Haring Index** has increased by **+310%** from 2000 to 2022.



Stability

As an investment opportunity, art has consistently **outperformed other asset classes, such as the S&P 500 and FTSE 100, over the past 20 years.**

Art's lack of liquidity functions favorably for assets with **value stability and low correlation with the stock market.**



Track Record

The majority of Haring's subway drawings were created directly in the subway stations of New York City and were not meant to be preserved. As a result, only a small fraction of these drawings survived, making them exceedingly rare and sought after. This rarity drove prices from \$5,000 to \$8,000 in 1996 to a record value of **\$1,157,317 at Christie's New York in 2019.**

- Subway drawings represent a form of "street art" that captures the energy, vibrancy, and social commentary of New York City during the 1980s. They hold cultural and artistic value beyond their monetary worth. Such blue-chip artworks are perfect for short-term investments.
- If one of the following two conditions is met, the sale of the asset is considered:
 - End of the defined investment horizon has been reached.
 - Ambitious case already occurs before the end investment horizon.
