The demand for luxury watches remains exceptionally high. The supply in the secondhand market cannot meet this demand.

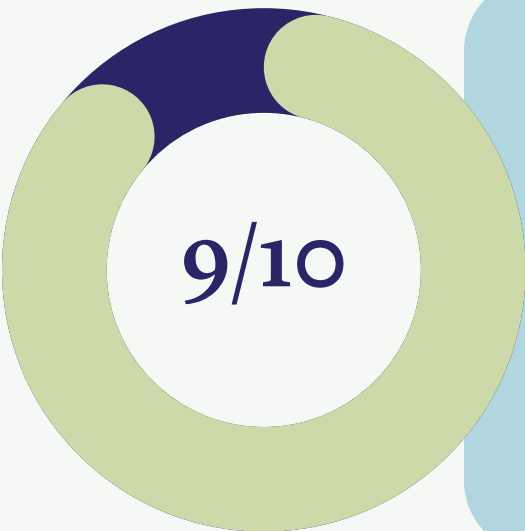
According to the Chrono24 website, the watch has a performance index of 1.06, which means that its value has increased by 6% since December 25, 2023.

The Patek Philippe Complications World Time Chronograph, 5930G-001 is a model highly coveted by collectors and fans. In the last twelve months, our watch has experienced price fluctuations of 6%. In comparison, the S&P 500 index has seen price fluctuations of almost 25%, highlighting the stability of this benchmark.



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Track Record

Founded in 1839, it is the last family-owned watchmaker in Geneva. It is one of the most popular watch brands in the world. Due to their limited production, Patek Philippe watches have also been popular among investors for decades.

The watches tend to hold their value well and, in some cases, appreciate over time.
