Rationale for exiting the investment opportunity:

 This investment opportunity was exited in March 2025 after 5 months with a realized net profit of 25.1%.

Successful Exit of Our First Sneaker Investment:

The successful sale of the Loro Piana x New Balance 990v6 marks a milestone for Splint Invest as our first-ever sneaker exit. The transaction, executed through a private sale to a collector within our network, resulted in an impressive realized return of 25.1% in just 0.4 years. This extremely short holding period, combined with strong returns, significantly outperforms our balanced scenario projection of 15.5% annualized return, confirming the strength of sneakers as an alternative asset class.

Why an Early Exit? ?

The performance of the Loro Piana x New Balance 990v6 over the last five months exceeded our expectations. Given this rapid appreciation, we decided to test the private market to explore the potential for an early realization of gains. This strategy proved successful, allowing us to secure an attractive return within a fraction of the original investment horizon.

Details of the Exit Decision:

The Loro Piana x New Balance 990v6 was released as an investment opportunity on Splint Invest in October 2024, with an anticipated holding period of 3 to 5 years. Due to high market demand and strong price appreciation, we successfully exited the investment in March 2025, achieving a significantly shorter holding period while surpassing expected returns.

The final sale price after commission was €6,800, with an adjusted distributed amount of €7,007 after external cost adjustments and exit fees.

The Loro Piana x New Balance 990v6, limited to just 1,000 pairs, benefited from a surge in market demand, making it one of the most sought-after collaborations of 2024.

Conclusion:

The first successful sneaker exit highlights the significant potential of the market as an alternative asset class. The strong return, combined with an accelerated holding period, showcases the effectiveness of our investment strategy in identifying high-value opportunities early.
