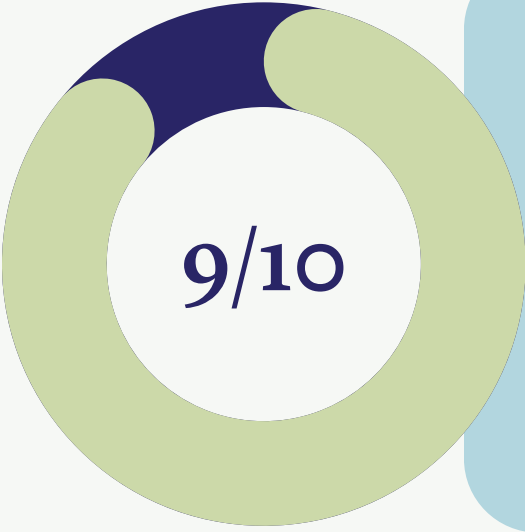

The restricted liquidity of art proves beneficial for assets that emphasize stability in value and show a minimal correlation with stock market fluctuations.

Using acrylics on canvas, he portrays daily life with a light-hearted yet ironic touch, blending normalcy and primitivism with a 21st-century flair. Willem has showcased his art in Germany, Russia, and Belgium.

In 2022, half of his auctioned works exceeded \$150,000, surpassing estimates of \$10,000 to \$15,000.
