The artwork draws inspiration from the tragic events of Hurricane Katrina, portraying the New Orleans authorities' insufficient response to assist those in need. Released in 2008, it quickly captured global headlines due to its poignant message, making it one of Banksy's most sought-after pieces to date.

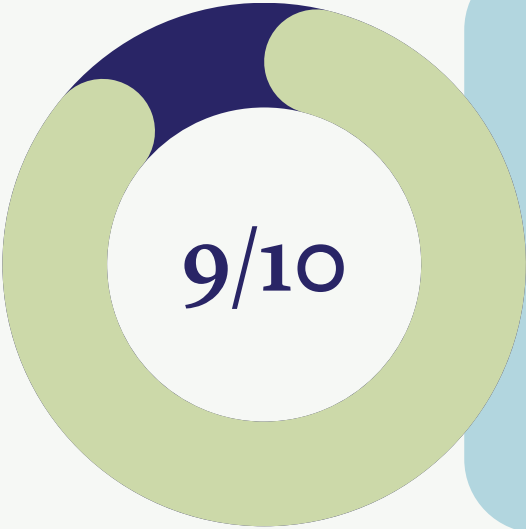

The average annual price increase of Nola is +14% from 2019 to 2020.

When it comes to investment opportunities, art has consistently shown better performance compared to other asset classes like the S&P 500 and the FTSE 100 throughout the last twenty years.

Stability

Banksy originals can sell for millions of pounds at auction, with the highest auction price being £18.6 million for "Love Is In The Bin". The Banksy market has performed exceptionally well over the past 15 years.

The favorable liquidity of artworks is particularly highlighted, especially for assets with a consistent value and showing little correlation with the stock market.

Track Record

Multiple variations of the artwork are available in varying colours. White Rain has seen one of the fastest Average Annual Growth rate alongside Orange Rain of all available options. The first Nola signed print was released later in 2008 in a limited edition of 289 signed works.
