Over the past 3.5 years, Moyosore Martins' painting prices have soared by an impressive 450%, fueled by increasing demand from collectors. Currently, Moyo is featured in a group exhibition at Tang Contemporary in Hong Kong, highlighting the appeal to Chinese collectors. He has emerged as a cult figure among art enthusiasts.

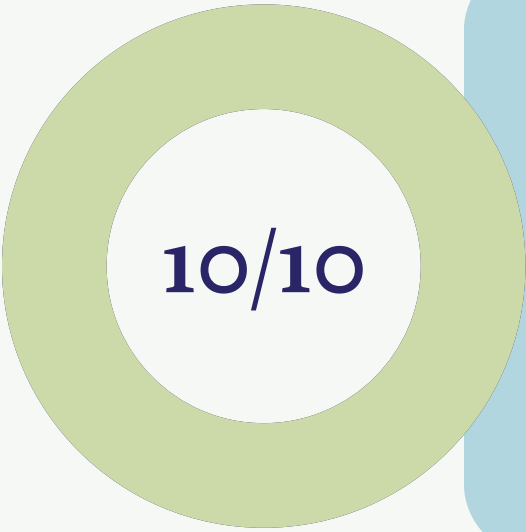

Based on the "2021 Global Art Market & COVID-19 Report" from Citi Private Bank, contemporary art saw a gain of 6.7%, outperforming other art segments which saw returns of 5.5%.

Martins' artworks have experienced a remarkable 450% surge in prices over the past 3.5 years, with these pieces being sourced directly from the artist's gallery.

Stability

When considering investment opportunities, art has shown superior performance compared to assets like the S&P 500 and the FTSE 100 in the last twenty years.

The limited ease of turning art into cash actually benefits it, especially for assets that maintain a steady value and have little connection to the fluctuations of the stock market.

Track Record

Martins has showcased his work in fifteen gallery exhibitions so far, including prominent occasions like Scope Miami, Art Basel Hong Kong, and Now, They Know... in Beirut.

He intends to continue exhibiting his work in the future, with upcoming shows including one at Galerie T in Paris scheduled for October 2024.
