Return Potential

An investment of 500 EUR is projected to be worth approximately 1,365 EUR in 4 years.

Hot Emerging Artists

The prices for Móyòsóré Martins' paintings, sized 180 x 150 cm, have developed from \$5,000 USD to currently \$27,500 USD over the past three and a half years. His works have been collected by over 125 collectors, with approximately 170 paintings sold during this period. He has become something of a cult figure. There have been fifteen gallery exhibitions, two upcoming, in Hong Kong in March and Paris in October. The demand for his works is steady as the collector base expands.



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Fun facts:

His father forbade him from studying art as a child, so he pursued computer science until he moved to New York in 2015 to pursue his artistic passion.

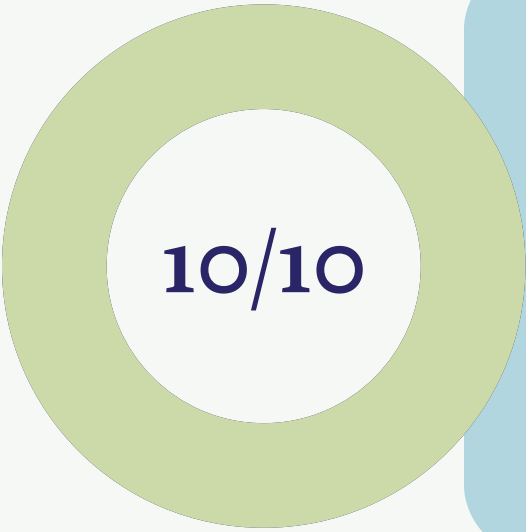

Return

According to the "2021 Global Art Market & COVID-19 Report" by Citi Private Bank, contemporary art showed a growth of 6.7%, surpassing other categories of art that had returns of 5.5%.

Martins' art pieces have seen a significant increase in prices by 450% over the last 3.5 years, with these works being acquired directly from the artist's gallery.

Stability

When assessing investment options, art has demonstrated stronger performance over the past two decades when compared to assets such as the S&P 500 and the FTSE 100.

The relative difficulty of liquidating art assets actually works in its favor, particularly for assets that maintain a consistent value and are less influenced by stock market fluctuations.

Track Record

Martins has presented his artwork in fifteen gallery exhibitions thus far, participating in notable events such as Scope Miami, Art Basel Hong Kong, and Now, They Know... in Beirut.

He plans to persist in exhibiting his work in the future, with forthcoming showcases including an exhibition at Galerie T in Paris slated for October 2024.
