The growth has been particularly notable in recent years, with a remarkable 13% YOY growth observed between 2020 and 2023.

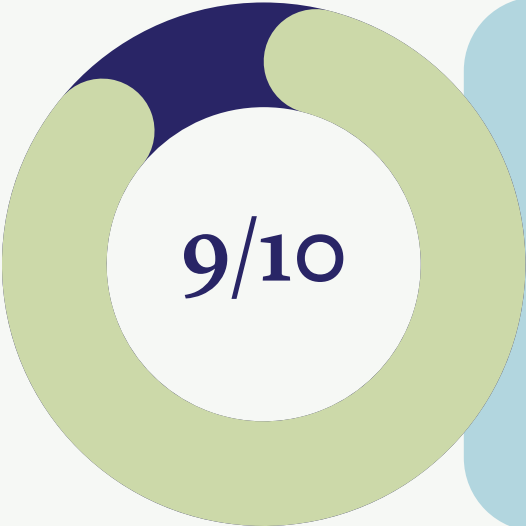


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Stability
