Stability

There are only 57 German version Charizard Holo 1st Edition cards graded PSA10, making them even rarer than the English version, of which 124 PSA10 graded cards are available.

Pokémon cards are fundamentally not reprinted. Once an era goes "out of print," there are no new editions. Consequently, historically, the prices for cards remain relatively stable.
