The Sports Memorabilia Index reports that sports memorabilia has experienced an average annual performance of 14.5% between 2008 and 2021, outperforming the S&P 500.

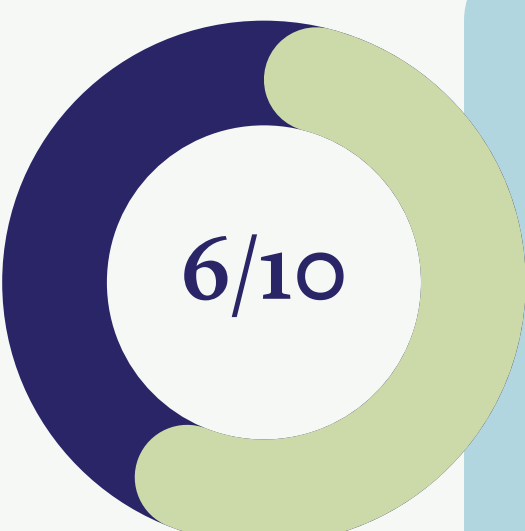
In turn, the average annual performance of polo shirts signed and inscribed by Tiger Woods over the last 10 years is +20.0%.

Track Record

Tiger wore this white Stanford Polo during the third round of the Farmers Insurance Open on January 27, 2013. He personally inscribed the polo with 'Go Stanford, 1/27/13, R3 Farmers Insurance Open'. The day after wearing it, Tiger secured his 75th PGA tournament victory. This Stanford Nike polo, worn by Tiger Woods during the tournament, is exceptionally rare and comes with genuine authentication, having been obtained legally from Tiger Woods himself.
