Return Potential

Italian violins from the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries are in high demand among soloists worldwide. Particularly noteworthy is the extremely limited number of instruments by this master. This soloist's instrument, with excellent projection and good condition, is considered a valuable work of art.

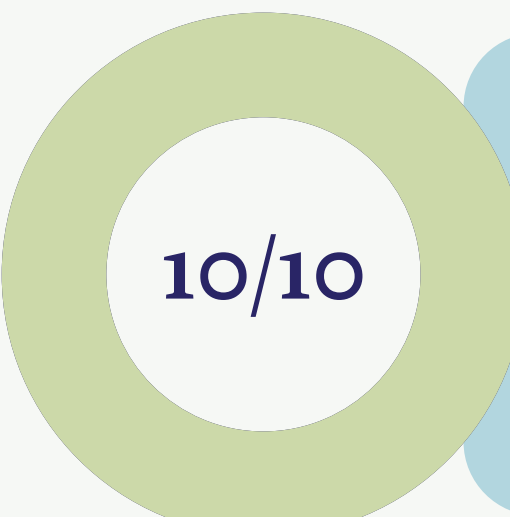

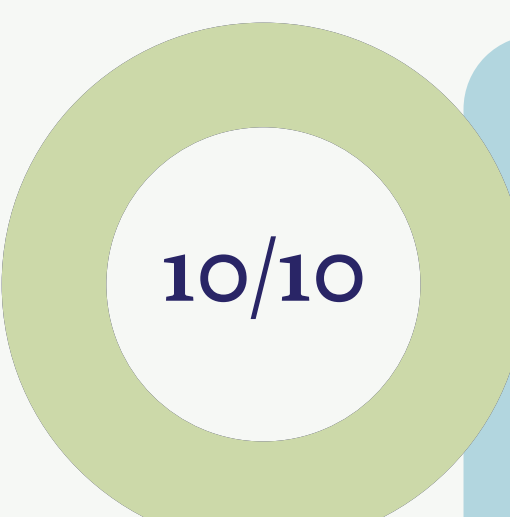
In the last two decades, growth for instruments in this category has accelerated to an impressive 11% per year, highlighting the attractiveness of this investment form.

Track Record

Historical and contemporary high-quality string instruments have shown that they appreciate in value over time, making them an attractive investment option. The limited supply, increasing rarity, and growing demand from musicians, collectors, and enthusiasts contribute to the potential for value appreciation. Only very few instruments made by this maker are available, and they are rarely traded.

 - Ambitious case already occurs before the end investment horizon.
