Finally, in the ambitious scenario, we applied 100% of the average annual price increase since 2021 of the existing Neo Unlimited Display Boxes (Destiny, Genesis, and Revelation).

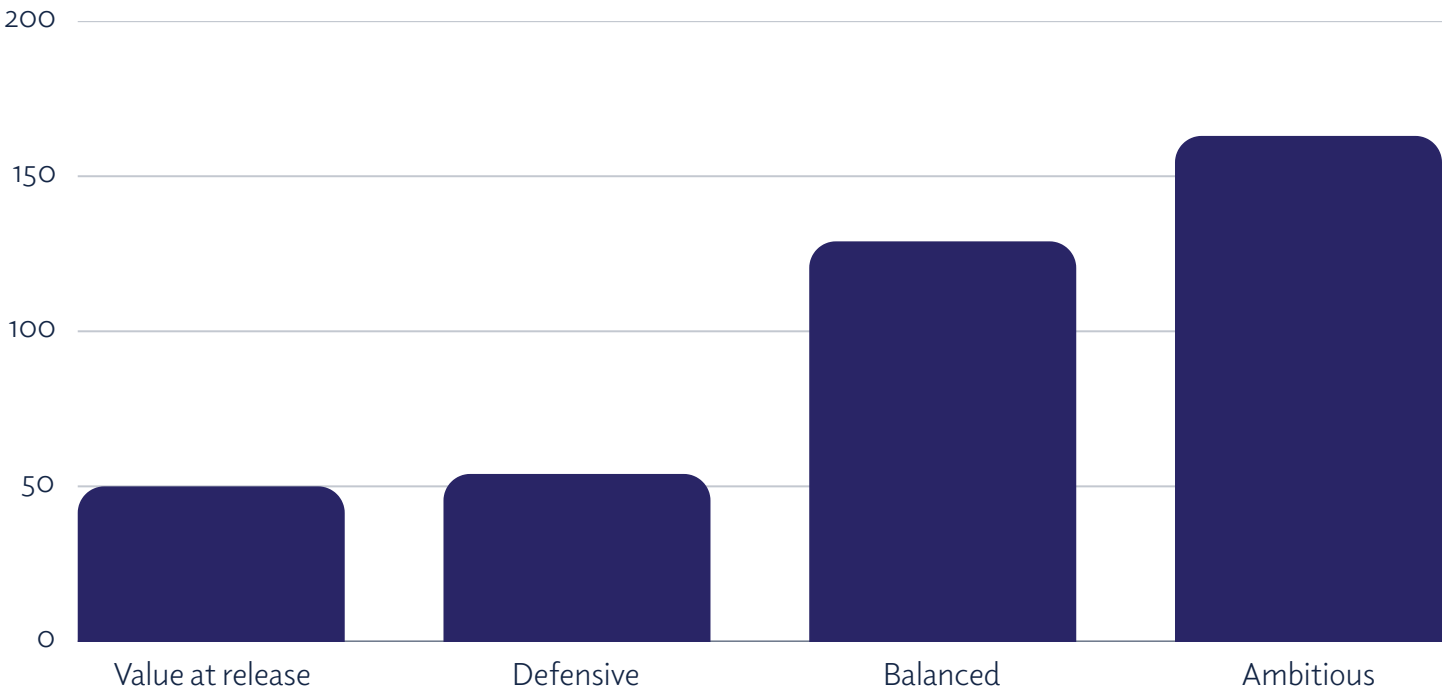
