

Château Mouton Rothschild 2014 - Methuselah

- Average annual increase in value of almost 7.6% for vintages released between 2004 and 2013 over the last 5 years

Rating



Return

The 2013 vintage has achieved the highest average increase in value over the last five years at **7.95%**. The average of the vintages published between 2004 and 2013 is **7.61%**.

The 2014 vintage has the highest upside potential when comparing bottle prices to critic ratings for each vintage (**R=0.64**). We expect that the price of our vintage will achieve a higher increase in value.



Stability

Chateau Mouton Rothschild receives excellent ratings from famous international wine critics: The **2014** vintage received **95 Parker and 99 Suckling points**. This is due to, among other things, the production volume, which is limited to **20,000** cases.

The 2006 vintage has achieved the lowest average appreciation of just under **2%** over the last five years.



Track Record

Chateau Mouton Rothschild has been cultivated since the early **18th century**, when the estate was owned by the de Segur family.

The bottles or vintages of Chateau Mouton Rothschild are also part of the **Liv-Ex Bordeaux 500** and **Fine Wine 50 Index**, which measures the return and appreciation of quality wine for investors for over 15 years.
