Return

The Nautilus Travel Time Chronograph – reference 5990/1A-001 by Patek Philippe is a masterpiece of special equilibrium and has achieved an **increase in value of 26.5 %** in the last 12 months alone.



Stability

For the past twelve months, the Nautilus Travel Time Chronograph – reference 5990/1A-001 shows **price fluctuations of 14.8 %**.

In comparison, the **S&P500 index** shows a price fluctuation of **almost 25 %**, which underlines the stability of the asset.

Founded in **1839**, Patek Philippe is the last family-owned watch manufacturer in Geneva. It is one of the most popular watch brands in the world.

Due to the limited production, the watches have also been popular with investors for decades. The **Patek Philippe index** reaches an **average annual appreciation of 27 %** over the last 5 years.
