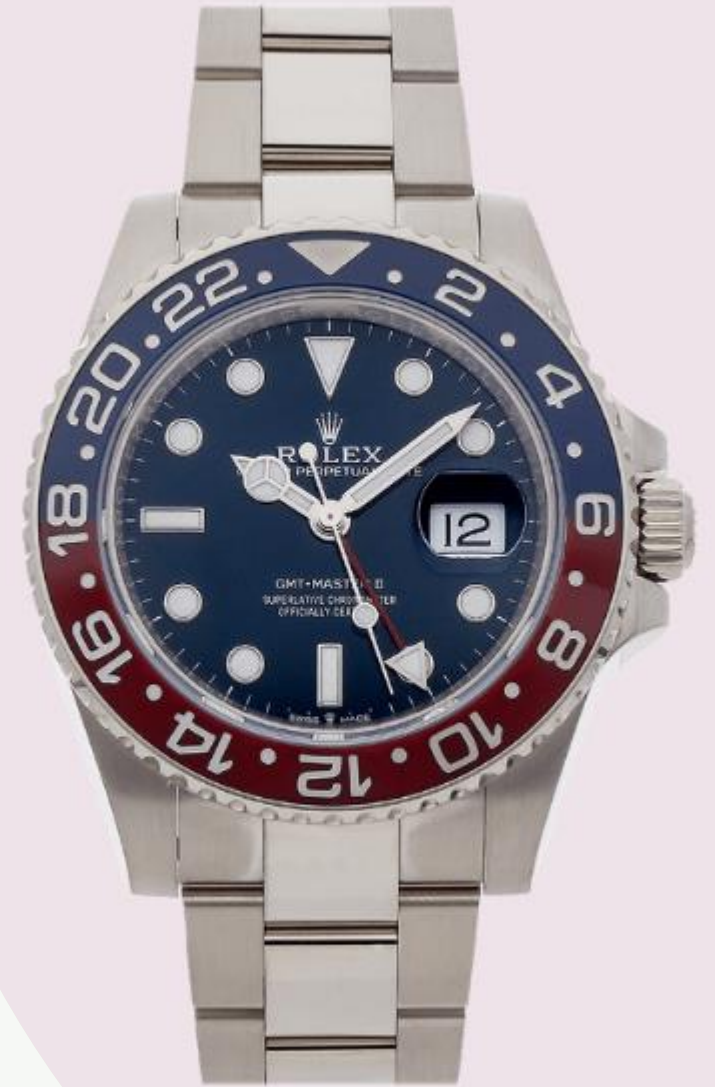


Rolex, GMT-Master II, Reference 126719BLRO
